

GRANDRAVINE COVID PROTOCOLS FOR 2021/2022 SEASON

Entering Grandravine Arena:

- All must enter through the Grandravine Community Centre doors (north end of building) for screening. City staff will be checking for proof of vaccination and government ID. These must be presented to the screener each week upon arrival.
- Toronto Public Health has advised us that self-screening must be done by all who attend Grandravine Special Hockey program. Forms are required at each practice and will be available to print from the Grandravine website.
- All must wear a mask at all times including coaches while on ice. Physical distancing regulations must be followed with others, with the exception of your family members.
- All must exit through the Grandravine Arena doors (south side of building). Entrance will not be allowed through these doors.
- All must arrive 15 minutes prior to scheduled practice time for screening.
- Due to capacity limits, we would like to keep the parent/caregiver limit, to 1 to each player (where a parent/caregiver is a volunteer this does not apply)
- Players and/or the parents/caregivers who come to the arena with them have to be the only ones who put on their skates. Coaches will not be allowed to help with fixing skates or helmets even when they are on the benches or the ice.
- Public washrooms are open. However, no one is allowed to use the washrooms in the dressing rooms

Players:

- Player must arrive fully dressed 15 minutes prior to their start time and proceed to the area you are guided to by a team rep to put your skates on.
- Players do not require to physical distance or wear a mask while on the ice.
- No sharing of equipment, water bottles, towels etc. There will not be any equipment available from the Grandravine storage room due to health and safety regulations.
- Players must be off the ice at their practice end time and proceed to where they will remove their skates and exit immediately. There will no loitering anywhere in the facility.
- Goalies are the only ones allowed to use dressing rooms
- In case of an Injured player – coaches will be masked and gloved – they can help someone who is injured. If you need an ambulance, let someone else know and stay with the player.
- Any player who doesn't want to get up off the ice will be left on the ice, if he or she is not injured. Coaches will not be allowed to help them up. Parents or siblings are also not allowed to enter the ice to help unless they register ahead of time as a volunteer and are fully insured.
- Players' masks should be left in the player's hockey bag in a zip lock bag

Registration:

Season Start: October 16, 2021

Season End: April 2, 2022

Registration forms will be available on our website and must be completed and a copy sent to jsrizzuto@rogers.com as soon as possible, no later than October 12, 2021. Due to the process change in obtaining insurance, players must be registered with their organization prior to start date. This will allow us time to submit the players' names to be covered by insurance.
