### **FLAG RAISING CEREMONY**

March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2026 – 11:00AM  
Nathan Phillips Square, Toronto City Hall  
Bay & Queen St.

The City of Toronto will raise the SHI tournament flag that will fly at Toronto City Hall for the duration of the tournament. If you are a visitor and are in town on the Wednesday, please try to make to this event. Besides the flag raising, City Hall and Nathan Phillips Square are Toronto landmarks worth visiting.

There is no access to the Podium Roof from Nathan Phillips Square. To access the podium roof for the flag raising ceremony those attending will need to come in the front doors of City Hall and then go up the east tower elevator to the 3rd floor using elevators E1, E3 or E4. These are the only elevators that will take you to the Podium Roof level. The doors across from the elevator lead out to the podium roof, you will need to go to the left when you exit and go around the east tower to the courtesy flag pole.


### **OPENING CEREMONIES**

Please note that because of construction, currently there is slightly restricted access at the Herbert H. Carnegie Centennial Centre.

#### **Parking**

- Although Google maps shows 2 driveways, there is currently only one driveway in use for both entry and exit.
- For buses please use the designated drop off point. Then proceed to the designated bus parking area. We ask bus drivers to move right up to the front to make it easier for buses arriving behind you.
- We will be using the rear entrance instead of the main front entrance. Please do not stop with your car or bus in front of the entrance to the building.



## Ceremonies

- Please arrive by 7:45AM so that your team can be lined up in place for the athlete's parade.
- Athletes are asked to wear their jerseys. Skates and helmets are not required.
- Volunteers will be available near the entrance to direct you.
- Signs will be placed by the walls where your team will line up. This sign is to be carried by one of your players at the front of your team.
- Spectators will be asked to go to the spectator area on the second level. Signs will be placed along the walkway designating the area for your team. This is meant as a general suggestion to make easier for teams to sit together. It is not meant to be a seat reservation.
- Following the ceremonies please head to the arena right way if your team is playing at 11AM. Both arenas are approximately 15 minutes from the Herbert H. Carnegie Centennial Centre.


## GAMES

Games will be held at Scotiabank Pond and Chesswood Arena. These facilities are just 5 minutes apart. Scotiabank Pond will serve as the tournament hub. The registration desk and souvenirs sales will be located here. There will be an information table at Chesswood Arena.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** When you use Google Maps or other Navigation app, be sure to specify Scotiabank Pond and NOT Scotiabank Arena. Otherwise, you will be sent downtown to the Toronto Maple Leafs home rink, which is about 20 kilometres away.

Both Scotiabank Pond and Chesswood Arena have specified bus parking. If you are coming by car please leave this space free for buses only. If coming by bus, please be sure to park in the designated area only. This will help make things smoother for everyone.

## Special Hockey International Tournament Rules

- To participate in the SHI Annual Tournament all organizations must be a member of SHI in good standing
- All players eligible to play in the tournament must be on an approved roster or equivalent official document. A copy of current player/team insurance must be provided at time of tournament check in.
- All players participating in the game must appear on the game sheet.
- All teams must be prepared to start play 15 minutes in advance of the schedule time.
- No checking allowed.
- No slap shots allowed.
- Penalties shots will be issued for tripping and holding.
- 2 minute penalties will be issued for players exhibiting aggressive behavior.
- 5 minute penalties for rough play or slashing.
- Fighting will result in immediate expulsion from the Tournament.
- Blue line off sides will be waived and not called.
- Icing the puck will be waived and not called. Goalies should try to keep the puck in play
- Referee decisions are final
- Helmets, neck guards and full cages are mandatory, mouth guards are optional
- Continued rough play from an individual or team will be brought to the attention of an SHI disciplinary committee which may result in the expulsion of that player and/or team. Should this situation continue to arise during tournament games, it will be brought up to the SHI Board Committee.
- Every effort must be made to ensure that each player has equal ice time. No double shifting. Each team may have 5 skaters plus 1 goaltender on the ice during play. In addition, roamers (maximum of 3 per team on ice at one time) may be on the ice during play with both coaches in agreement. Roaming players can, but are not required to utilize coaches for balance. All on ice participants must wear helmets. There is no limit to the number of players a team has on its roster for a game.
- A maximum of 6 team officials are allowed on the bench which includes a maximum of 3 coaches that are on the ice with a max of 3 non-skaters and novice players at one time. This will allow players with very little game experience to get help with lining up for face-offs correctly and to encourage the outgoing line to get off the ice. Coaches must not carry sticks or in any way influence the play and/or flow of the game
- Clubs with more than one team registered may not substitute players back and forth. The only exception will be if the goalie is hurt or sick.
- If a floater is in the opposite end, and the puck is passed to him/her resulting in a goal being scored, it shall only be allowed if the players' ability does not allow him/her to clear the opposition's end zone
- The Tournament Director and/or Committee have final say on all rules and regulations and/or the interpretation of those. The Tournament Director's decision is final. No protests will be heard.
- In accordance with the true spirit of SHI League, each coach should attempt to match lines with similarly skilled players from the other team. While this may be difficult to achieve, every effort should be made to comply with this requirement.
- Play time will consist of three, 15 minute running time periods with a 3 minute buzzer system and no stop time between changing of lines. No time outs will be permitted.
- For "A" Level games, the coaches can discuss either playing the 3 minute buzzer system or changing on the fly. They will also consist of three, 15 minute running time periods with no stop time between line changes.

- 2 minute warm up time before start of each game. Referee will blow whistle for start of game.
- Tournament teams may consist of A (senior), B (intermediate), C (junior) or Mixed (which consist of a combination of A, B, C players). This will give teams with a low registered amount of athletes of different abilities the opportunity to play every club in SHI.
- No Camera's, cell phones or electronic devices allowed behind the bench, except for Tournament photographer, Yearbook photographer, and Tournament Committee member. Anyone other than persons mentioned will be asked to leave. If a team would like to take pictures please see Tournament Committee member for the best spot in arena to take pictures.

## Dressing Rooms

Dressing room allocations will be posted on video screens. As well, your team name will be attached to the dressing room door. Locks for the dressing rooms will be available at the information table in the lobby of each arena. You will be required to leave your driver's licence as security for the return of the locks.

## Timekeepers

For A level games, if you wish to have line changes on the fly, a coach must inform the timekeepers prior to the start of the game. If you do not inform the timekeeper, the buzzer will sound every three minutes for line changes. For all other levels this option does not apply. The buzzer will sound every three minutes for line changes.

## Video

A tournament video is being produced that will be made available to all teams. An email will be sent after the tournament when it is ready for download.

## Photography

Top Drawer Images will provide photo services for the tournament. They will be set up at Scotiabank Pond, but will send photographers to Chesswood as needed. Individual or team action photo packages need to be pre-ordered with Top Drawer Images either prior to the tournament or at Scotiabank Pond. If you have already pre-ordered photo packages you will be able to pick them up at the Top Drawer Images table.


## 50/50 Draw



- Teams will enter from two directions to ensure smooth flow and proceed to one of the first two presenters.
- After receiving medals, athletes will return in the same direction as they came. Please do not linger in the presentation area.
