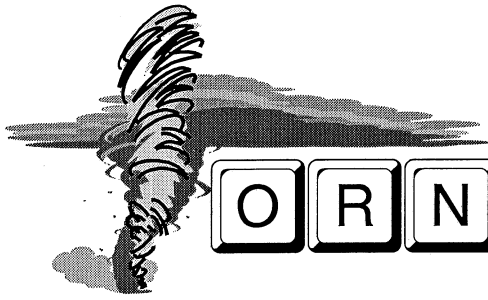

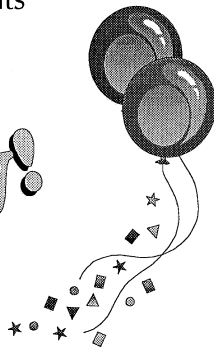

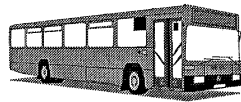
An Extra-big Thank You

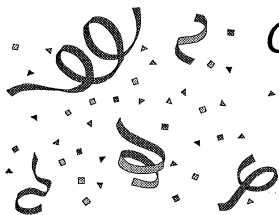
We're getting closer to season end. Only three more buses are scheduled.

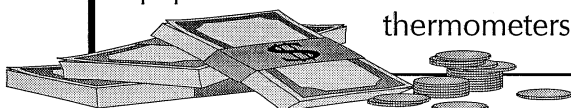
. . . **Sunny Bhandal** for correctly answering this question in the February newsletter:
